With the government lifting the restrictions to allow groups of 20 or less to meet, there is obviously room for small groups of people to consider what that means for them. After discussion with the church board, I have sent out information to our group leaders (let me know if you did not get the email and should have) explaining the government requirements for a group to meet.

At the moment this is not straight forward and there are a number of steps for groups to comply with if they wish to restart. There is also some risk involved. Group leaders will be considering all of this and making decisions about whether they are comfortable with all of the requirements, so please be patient and supportive of your group leader during this process. My suggestion is that for many of our groups it may be worth waiting until things become a little easier before re-launching. Please speak to your leader if you have questions or you are welcome to ring me to chat about the processes involved.

- For permanent housing as one of our clients is living in a hostel and is on the housing waiting list but there is a 3 year wait.
- There are a few clients requesting prayer for new jobs or for the job they are in to be made permanent.

Thank you to those who have been so generous during this period and for the large number of people who have offered help. There have only been limited requests for help so far and we will keep you informed if more needs arise.
